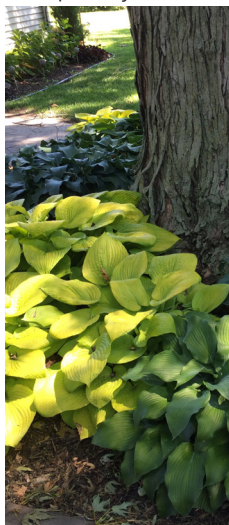




# LOW MAINTENANCE LANDSCAPE PLANTS

## **Site Preparation:**
