Sun Exposure:

Start watching how many hours of sunlight your space gets.

6 or more hours of direct sunlight -

- look for full sun plants.

Morning sun/afternoon shade -

- look for part sun plants.

Dappled sun or mostly shaded -

- look for part sun to full shade plants

Amount of Space Available:

Keep your intended space in mind as you refer to a plants mature height and spread to fill your area.

Foliage or Bloom Color:

There are many choices based on personal preference. Consider surroundings, such as plants nearby, and existing structures like walls or fences. Leafy plants add great foliage color or seasonal bloom to the space.

Evergreen:

From needles to soft green foliage, evergreens provide interest year-round, especially in the winter. Incorporate at least one in a mixed bed.

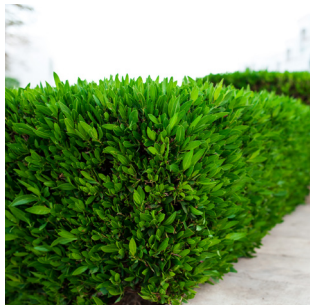

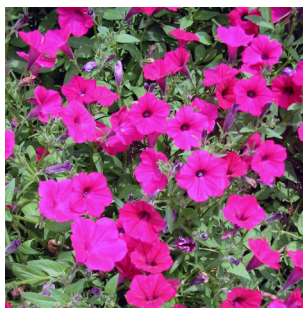
