Perennials are plants that come back every year. Most bloom with flowers for a specified period of time. For the best success follow these simple guidelines:

Companions:

Perennials look great when planted with other perennials, complimented with annual flowers, or placed near existing shrubs and trees.

Height:

Choose types with varying heights - plant taller to the back and shorter to the front.

Bloom Time:

Select types that bloom at different times of the season and not all at the same time. A mixture of spring blooms with summer favorites makes a great look.

Color:

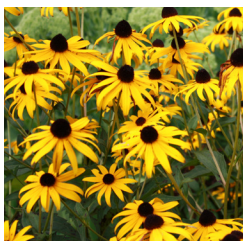
Choose one color scheme or a complimenting mixture. There is no right or wrong - Just ask Mother Nature.

Several plants of the same kind will create more impact.



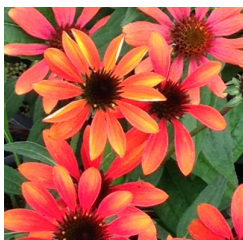

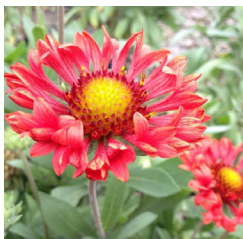

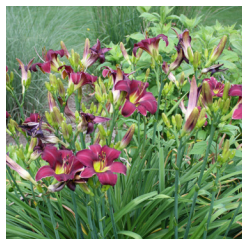
